2009 Wisconsin Act 125 [2009 Senate Bill 413]

Abatement of Residential Nuisances

2009 Wisconsin Act 125 amends the law relating to receivership for abatement of residential nuisances.

Prior to Act 125, only a city of the first or second class was authorized to place a nuisance residential property into receivership. The purpose of a receivership is to remove, suspend, or correct a nuisance.

Act 125 extends to any city, village, or town the authority to place a nuisance residential property into receivership.

Effective date: The Act takes effect on March 4, 2010.
