

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 130 [2009 Assembly Bill 47]

Certain Offenders Disqualified from Martial Arts Instruction

Under 2009 Wisconsin Act 130 (the Act), anyone who instructs in self-defense or combat, excluding the instruction of the use of a firearm, bow and arrow, or crossbow, is required to obtain a martial arts instructor permit. Currently, the fee for the instructor permit is \$53. The Act requires the Department of Justice to conduct a background check on an applicant for a martial arts instructor permit. The Act disqualifies a person from obtaining a permit if one of the following applies:

- The person is required to register as a sex offender under s. 301.45 (1g), Stats.
- The person has been convicted of first-degree intentional homicide.

Effective date: 2009 Wisconsin Act 130 becomes effective on March 4, 2010.
