

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 189 [2009 Senate Bill 168]

Barber and Cosmetologist Apprentices

Under current law, a person may learn barbering or cosmetology through an apprentice. Current law provides that no apprentice may practice barbering or cosmetology except under the supervision of a licensed manager.

2009 Wisconsin Act 189 permits a licensed manager to delegate supervisory authority over an apprentice to a licensed barber or cosmetologist who has completed at least 2,000 hours of practice as a licensed barber or cosmetologist.

Effective date: Wisconsin Act 189 took effect on March 30, 2010.
