

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 207 [2009 Senate Bill 423]

Library Boards of Public Libraries in a First Class City

A public library established in a 1st class city is administered by a library board consisting of various members, including a member of the county board of supervisors. Under *prior law*, the county board member appointed to the library board must reside in the county but outside the city. 2009 *Wisconsin Act 207* removes the requirement that the county board member reside outside the city.

Under *prior law*, for a library board of a public library in a 1^{st} class city, seven members constitute a quorum. The *Act* provides, instead, that a majority of those seats on the library board that are currently filled constitutes a quorum.

Effective date: The Act took effect on May 6, 2010.
