

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 233 [2009 Senate Bill 475] Reimbursement of Counties and Indian Tribes

2009 Wisconsin Act 233 relates to the reimbursement of counties and Indian tribes for unexpected or unusually high-cost out-of-home care placements of Indian juveniles who have been adjudicated delinquent by tribal courts.

Prior to the enactment of Act 233, the statutes provided that specified appropriations were to be used for unexpected or unusually high-cost out-of-home care placements of Indian juveniles who were adjudicated delinquent.

Act 233 clarifies that the reimbursement for these placements will only be made for individual juveniles adjudicated delinquent by tribal courts.

Effective date: The Act takes effect on May 20, 2010.
