

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 317 [2009 Senate Bill 622] Number of Raffles Permitted in a Year

2009 Wisconsin Act 317 amends the statutes regarding the number of raffles permitted in a year.

Current law provides that a qualified organization may not conduct more then 200 raffles or more than one calendar raffle during a year. Act 317 provides that a raffle under a Class B license to which all of the following apply is only one raffle for purposes of the current law:

- 1. More than one drawing is held and more than one prize is awarded on the same date and at the same location.
- 2. Drawings for each prize or group of prizes are made from a container specific to each prize or group of prizes.
- 3. The raffle ticket purchaser places his or her ticket in the container of his or her choice.

*Effective date:* The Act takes effect on May 27, 2010.
