

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 326 [2009 Assembly Bill 32]

Department of Transportation Employer Notification Program

Currently, the Department of Transportation (DOT) administers an employer notification program. Under this program, if an employer of a commercial motor vehicle driver registers the driver's name with the DOT, they will be informed by the DOT whenever a traffic-related conviction, suspension, revocation, cancellation, disqualification, or out-of-service order is recorded on the person's driving record.

2009 Wisconsin Act 326 extends the employer notification program to allow an employer to register any employee, not just commercial motor vehicle drivers, if the employee's responsibilities include the operation of any motor vehicle.
