

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2009 Wisconsin Act 387 [2009 Senate Bill 528] Methods of Voting by Members of a Cooperative

A member of a cooperative who is entitled to vote on a motion but absent from the membership meeting where the vote is held may vote by submitting a signed paper ballot, if the cooperative makes such ballots available to members.

2009 Wisconsin Act 387 specifies that an absent member may vote on a motion by electronic means if all of the following apply:

- 1. The cooperative permits voting by absentee ballot.
- 2. The bylaws provide for electronic voting.
- 3. The cooperative is able to authenticate the identity of the voting member.
- 4. The cooperative gives the vote the same effect as a paper absentee ballot.

Effective date: 2009 Wisconsin Act 387 takes effect on June 2, 2010.
