Assembly Bill 430 adds October 10 to the list of legal holidays in Wisconsin, creating a day of observation for William D. Hoard. Mr. Hoard was born on October 10, 1836 and was Wisconsin's 16th Governor. A legal holiday affects the filing of legal documents and elections may not be held on a legal holiday.

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 designates October 10 as William Hoard Day, recognizing him as the 16th Governor of Wisconsin and a leading promoter of the Wisconsin dairy industry. October 10 will not be a legal holiday.

Legislative History

On March 5, 2010, the Senate Committee on Ethics Reform and Government Operations introduced and adopted Senate Substitute Amendment 1 and recommended concurrence in the bill, as amended, both on votes of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
