Assembly Amendment 2 to 2009 Assembly Bill 607 makes the following changes in the bill:

1. Specifies that the term “dwelling” does not include a “tourist rooming house” as defined in s. 254.61 (6), Stats.
2. Revises the carbon monoxide detector requirement in the bill to:
 - a. Add “**garage**” to the exception to the requirement so that a carbon monoxide detector will be required in the basement and on each floor level, **except the attic, garage, or storage area** of each dwelling unit.
 - b. Create a provision specifying that the requirement that carbon monoxide detectors be installed so that they are powered by the dwelling’s electrical wiring system **does not apply** to a dwelling if the dwelling, **when initially constructed**, had no attached garage, no fireplace, and no fuel-burning appliance (as defined in the bill).
3. Changes the **effective date** of the bill, if enacted into law, to **February 1, 2011**. (Original bill had the first day of the 13th month after enactment as the effective date.)

Legislative History

At an executive session on January 26, 2010, the Assembly Committee on Consumer Affairs voted to adopt Assembly Amendment 2 to the bill on a vote of Ayes, 9; Noes, 0, and voted to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 8; Noes, 1.
