

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2009 Assembly Bill 756 would extend the dairy farm modernization and expansion tax credit for two years, ending with taxable years beginning in 2011, and would raise the limit on aggregate credit claims from \$50,000 to \$75,000.

Assembly Amendment 1 would specify that the increase in the aggregate tax credit limit would only apply to costs incurred after the effective date of the bill.

Assembly Amendment 2 exempts this bill from the statutory general fund balance requirement.

Legislative History

On February 25, 2010, Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by the Assembly Committee on Agriculture, which also recommended adoption of this amendment and passage of the bill, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 11; Noes, 0.

On April 7, 2010, Assembly Amendment 2 was introduced by the Joint Committee on Finance, which also recommended adoption of Assembly Amendments 1 and 2 and passage of the bill, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 15; Noes, 0.
