2009 Senate Bill 279 requires that, if a local unit of government (a county, city, village, or town) or a school district has an Internet site, it must post notices of and minutes for each meeting of each governmental body of the local unit of government or school district on that Internet site.

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 makes two changes to the bill:

- It deletes the requirement that meeting minutes be posted on the Internet site.
- It specifies that the requirements of the bill apply only to local units of government, and not to school districts.

Legislative History

On March 25, the Senate Committee on Rural Issues, Biofuels, and Information Technology voted to introduce and recommend adoption of Senate Substitute Amendment 1 and to recommend passage of Senate Bill 276 by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0.
