



2009 SENATE BILL 403

November 18, 2009 – Introduced by Senators ERPENBACH, RISSER, GROTHMAN and OLSEN, cosponsored by Representatives PARISI, TOWNSEND and BERCEAU. Referred to Committee on Health, Health Insurance, Privacy, Property Tax Relief, and Revenue.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 440.14 (1) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** authorizing the
2 release of certain personal identifying information collected by the Department
3 of Regulation and Licensing.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, if the Department of Regulation and Licensing requires an individual to provide certain personal identifying information for issuance or renewal of a credential or for obtaining a product or service, the department must allow the individual to opt out of being included in a release of such information the department provides in cases where the release includes information about ten or more individuals. Currently, an individual's decision to opt out applies to the release of the individual's name, social security number, telephone number, street address, post-office box number, and zip code.

Under the bill, an individual's decision to opt out applies only to the release of the individual's social security number, telephone number, street name and number, and post-office box number.
