

Dear Representative Black:

On June 19, 2008, Representative Scott Gunderson forwarded to my office the Assembly Natural Resource Committee's adopted motion with respect to the subject rule package. The motion requested that the Department consider modifications to the rule relating to air quality standards to repeal the existing standard for total suspended particulates. On June 30, 2008, I responded to Representative Gunderson, indicating that the Department agreed to consider modifications to the rule package and would notify the Committee when a decision had been made on the proposed modifications.

After considering the proposed modifications, the Department has decided not to modify the rule package as requested by the Committee and is notifying the Committee of that decision under s. 227.19(4)(b)2., Stats. Please contact Al Shea of my staff if you have questions about this matter.
