

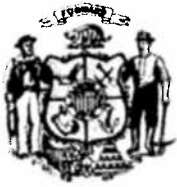

November 10, 2009 - Introduced by LAW REVISION COMMITTEE. Referred to  
Committee on Rules.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** amending and revising under s. 10.53 various provisions of  
2 ss. 10.62 to 10.82 of the statutes for the purpose of correcting conflicts between  
3 the listings in ss. 10.62 to 10.82 and the substantive statutes to which those  
4 sections refer. (Correction Bill).

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### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

The individual changes made by this correction bill are explained in the NOTES  
provided by the Legislative Reference Bureau in the body of the bill.

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*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do  
enact as follows:*

5 **SECTION 1.** 10.66 (2) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:  
6 10.66 (2) (a) 1. December 1 preceding the spring election is the earliest date  
7 nomination papers may be circulated for candidates running in the spring election.  
8 See ss. 8.05 (3) (a) and (4) (b) and 8.10 (2).

NOTE: Adds clarifying language.

9 **SECTION 2.** 10.66 (2) (a) 3. of the statutes is created to read:

**ASSEMBLY BILL 567**

1           10.66 (2) (a) 3. The deadline for electors of a village to file a petition requesting  
2 a primary for the spring election is December 1 preceding the spring election. See  
3 s. 8.11 (1m) (c).

NOTE: Creates provision consistent with 2007 Wis. Act 83, section 4.

4           **SECTION 3.** 10.66 (3) (aw) of the statutes is renumbered 10.66 (3) (aw) 1. and  
5 amended to read:

6           10.66 (3) (aw) 1. The deadline for a city or village to decide to hold a spring  
7 primary ~~or~~ for the spring election is 3 days after the first Tuesday in January  
8 preceding the spring election, or the next day if Tuesday is a holiday. See ss. 8.10 (2)  
9 and 8.11 (1) (a) and 8.11 (1m) (a).

10           2. The deadline for electors of a city to file a petition requesting a spring  
11 primary for the spring election is 3 days after the first Tuesday in January preceding  
12 the spring election, or the next day if Tuesday is a holiday. See ss. 8.10 (2) and 8.11  
13 (1) (a) ~~and~~ (c).

NOTE: 2007 Wis. Act 83, section 4, makes the deadline for deciding to hold a spring  
primary applicable to villages.

14           **SECTION 4.** 10.70 (1u) (a) of the statutes is created to read:

15           10.70 (1u) DECEMBER. (a) *December 1.* The deadline for electors of a village  
16 to file a petition requesting a primary for the spring election is December 1 preceding  
17 the spring election. See s. 8.11 (1m) (c).

NOTE: Creates provision consistent with 2007 Wis. Act 83, section 4.

18           **SECTION 5.** 10.70 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

19           10.70 (2) (b) *3 days after first Tuesday in January.* The deadline for electors  
20 of a city to file a petition ~~a city~~ requesting a primary for the spring election is 3 days  
21 after the first Tuesday in January preceding the spring election, or the next day if  
22 Tuesday is a holiday. See ss. 8.10 (2) and 8.11 (1) (c).

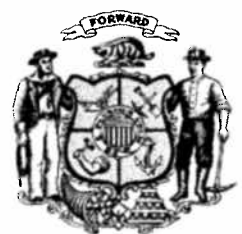
