**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 215**

October 18, 2011 – Offered by Representative BERNARD SCHABER.

1     **AN ACT** *to amend* 48.65 (2) (b); and *to create* 48.65 (2) (bm) of the statutes;  
2             **relating to:** requiring a public or private school that provides child care for  
3             children under three years of age to be licensed to operate a child care center.

---

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, no person may for compensation provide care and supervision for four or more children under seven years of age for less than 24 hours a day unless that person obtains a license to operate a child care center from the Department of Children and Families. Certain persons, however, including public and parochial schools, are exempt from this requirement. This substitute amendment requires a public or private school that provides such care and supervision for children under three years of age to obtain a license to operate a child care center.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4             **SECTION 1.** 48.65 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5             48.65 (2) (b) ~~A public or parochial school or a~~ tribal school.
