WHEREAS, more than 2.8 million women and girls live in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin recognizes the unique health needs of women in all phases of their lives; and

WHEREAS, access to comprehensive reproductive health care—including colposcopies, Pap smears, mammograms, treatment for sexually-transmitted infections, and birth control—is critical to the overall well-being of women and their families; and

WHEREAS, women's health care providers have saved countless lives by preventing and treating life-threatening diseases including breast, cervical, and ovarian cancers, and HIV-AIDS; and

WHEREAS, family planning is recognized by the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as one of the top ten public health achievements of the 20th century; and

WHEREAS, the state of Wisconsin values the many licensed health care professionals who provide this basic care in a compassionate setting, at times under threat of violence; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the Assembly, the Senate concurring, that the members of the Wisconsin Legislature strongly support comprehensive women's health care providers in their unique, positive contributions to the individual lives of women, men, and children — both before and after birth; and be it further

Resolved, that the Wisconsin Legislature recognizes, commends, and is grateful for the arduous, compassionate and sometimes dangerous work of thousands of staff and volunteers in comprehensive women's health centers across Wisconsin and the United States; and be it further
