Yes, I would be happy to draft the same sub with a new number, but I don't think that a credit is the active vehicle at this point. My understanding is that JCF today passed SSA 1 to SB 2, which is in effect a deduction (it adopts federal law regarding the deductibility of contributions to HSAs), so do you really want LRB s0002/1 drafted as a sub to SSA 1 to SB 2? I don't know if they passed the Assembly version, but I would imagine that the deduction is the route that the Assembly will follow too.

- **2.** Page 2, line 13: delete "accounts." and substitute "accounts, except that these provisions do not apply to an individual or a married couple if any of the following applies:".
 - **3.** Page 2, line 13: after that line insert:
- "(a) For a single individual, head of household, or married person who files a separate income tax return, his or her adjusted gross income is more than 500 percent of the federal poverty line.

- 1 (b) For a married couple who file a joint income tax return, their adjusted gross
- income is more than 500 percent of the federal poverty line.".
