2 **1.** Page 5, line 1: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
3 page 8, line 5, and substitute:

4 **"SECTION 3m.** 344.01 (2) (am) (intro.) and 1. of the statutes are amended to  
5 read:

6 344.01 (2) (am) (intro.) "Minimum liability limits" means, with respect to a  
7 motor vehicle policy of liability insurance, liability limits, ~~exclusive of interest and~~  
8 ~~costs,~~ in the following amounts:

- 9 1. Before January 1, 2010 ~~2016~~ <sup>2017</sup>, \$25,000 because of bodily injury to or death of
- 10 one person in any one accident and, subject to such limit for one person, \$50,000
- 11 because of bodily injury to or death of 2 or more persons in any one accident, and
- 12 \$10,000 because of injury to or destruction of property of others in any one accident.

2 2. Page 10, line 7: after that line insert:

3 “SECTION 17s. 632.32 (4) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 632.32 (4) (a) (intro.) Except as provided in par. (d) and subject to par. (e), every  
5 policy of insurance subject to this section that insures with respect to any owned  
6 motor vehicle registered or principally garaged in this state against loss resulting  
7 from liability imposed by law for bodily injury or death suffered by any person arising  
8 out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of a motor vehicle shall contain therein or  
9 supplemental thereto provisions for all of the following coverages:”

13 of the consumer price index over each 12-month period, all items, U.S. city average,  
14 as determined by the bureau of labor statistics of the U.S. department of labor.

15 2. Annually, beginning in July 2012, the commissioner shall adjust the dollar  
16 amounts required under par. (a) 1., 2m., and 3m. by the annual change in the  
17 consumer price index and publish the adjusted figures in the Wisconsin  
18 Administrative Register.”

19 4. Page 12, line 3: delete the material beginning with “121.555” and ending  
20 with line 4 and substitute “344.01 (2) (am) (intro.), 1., and 2.”.

21 5. Page 12, line 5: after “(4) (a)” insert “(intro.)”.
