SB 19 - Water disinfection amendment

Hi Becky,

We are looking to redraft the amendment to SB 19 that you had prepared for us, LRB-a0518. The DNR had an additional concern regarding the use of continuous disinfection in the scoring of grants, and we are seeking to address that concern. I have attached the language they are seeking below for your review. If you could take a look at that and incorporate it with the change drafted in LRB-a0518 into a single simple amendment, I would appreciate it. Feel free to contact me or the DNR with any questions you may have.

Thanks again for your willingness to take a look at this issue of making sure we maintain funding eligibility for municipal water systems that choose to do disinfection work.

Below is the language that we would suggest to accomplish this goal:

Modify s. 281.61 (6), Wis. Stats. This section currently reads:

"Priority List. The department shall establish a priority list that ranks each safe drinking water loan program project. The department shall promulgate rules for determining project rankings that, to the extent possible, give priority to projects that address the most serious risks to human health, that are necessary to ensure compliance with the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 USC 300f to 300j-26, and that assist local governmental units that are most in need on a per household basis, according to affordability criteria specified in the rules."

The following text could be added at the end of the paragraph: "For the purpose of scoring a project, upgrading a system to include continuous disinfection shall be scored as if it were a surface water system required to disinfect by administrative rules or federal law.


