This is a redraft of 2009 Senate Bill 301. The bill exempts certain shorelands from zoning under a county shoreland zoning ordinance. One of the criteria for exemption is that the majority of the buildings and structures in the shoreland area must have been used since January 1, 1990, until the effective date of the draft to conduct the affairs of small businesses. Under this draft, if at some point in the future the majority of the buildings and structures in that area are no longer used to conduct the affairs of small businesses, the exemption will still apply to the area. Is this consistent with your intent? If so, is January 1, 1990, in the draft still O.K.?
