Most District Attorneys believe implementation of this bill will have no fiscal impact on their offices. One DA, however, believes that prosecutors' workloads will increase because of those unable to pay the additional cost proposed in the bill: they will face jail time. The more expensive the penalties, the more litigation is needed by the DA to resolve the cases.
