1 AN ACT *to amend* 15.105 (5) of the statutes; **relating to:** the composition of the
2 State Capitol and Executive Residence Board.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, of the seven citizen members of the State Capitol and Executive Residence Board, three members must be interior designers. This bill provides instead that two of the citizen members must be interior designers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 15.105 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 15.105 (5) STATE CAPITOL AND EXECUTIVE RESIDENCE BOARD. There is created a
5 state capitol and executive residence board, attached to the department of
6 administration under s. 15.03, consisting of the secretary of administration or the
7 secretary's designee, the director of the historical society or the director's designee,
8 an architect or engineer employed by the department of administration appointed
9 by the secretary of administration, 3 senators and 3 representatives to the assembly

BILL**SECTION 1**

1 appointed as are the members of standing committees in their respective houses, and
2 7 citizen members appointed for staggered 6-year terms of whom at least 2 shall be
3 architects registered under ch. 443, one shall be a landscape architect registered
4 under ch. 443 and 3 2 shall be interior designers.

5 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

6 (1) This act first applies with respect to appointments made to the state capitol
7 and executive residence board on the effective date of this subsection.

You may wish to consider whether the interior designers who are members of the State Capitol and Executive Residence Board should be required to be registered with the Department of Regulation and Licensing under s. 440.962, stats. This would parallel the existing requirement for the architect and landscape architect members.
