Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

DAs did not provide a specific fiscal impact of this bill; rather, they stated that passage of new criminal legislation, without providing additional prosecutors, will place a further strain on resources and make it increasingly difficult to prosecute more and more of the cases that are referred to them. They are concerned that it already has affected their capacity to meet victim interests and hold criminal offenders accountable.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors didn't provide a fiscal estimate specific to this bill, but expressed concern about the increasing amount of legislation that they must enforce without adequate resources to do so.
