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Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a licensing system under which an individual is permitted to carry a concealed weapon. It would allow state or local governmental units to prohibit a licensee from carrying a firearm into a building that is owned, occupied or controlled by the state or the local governmental unit.

If the Department were to exercise this prohibition from carrying a firearm into a Department facility, there would need to be signage posted near all the entrances notifying individuals of this policy. The costs for these signs will be minimal and can be absorbed by the Department.

The local costs of posting signage at public entrances to local government buildings if they exercise the prohibition on carrying a firearm into those buildings cannot be determined.
