## To Tim Casper:

As we discussed, the budget bill repeals and recreates the appropriation schedule in chapter 20 of the statutes. If this legislation is passed before the budget bill, the appropriation change in this bill for the 2011–12 and 2012–13 fiscal years will be repealed when the budget is enacted. Additionally, section 16.47 (2) of the statutes provides that any bill that contains an appropriation or increases the cost of state government by more than \$10,000 may not be passed by either house of the legislature until the budget bill passes both houses unless the governor or the joint committee on finance recommends that the bill be passed.
