Description Providing information to a firearms dealer when purchasing a handgun, authorizing the Department of Justice to prosecute violations of certain laws regulating firearms, receiving a stolen firearm, and providing penalties.											

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

District Attorneys indicated that implementation of this bill could impact their workload due to additional jury trials, but that the increased number of cases likely would not be significant. In addition, the bill authorizes DOJ to prosecute some violations of this bill, which would reduce the additional workload to be faced by DA offices.

Any fiscal impact upon DA offices is expected to be minimal.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Should this bill be implemented, DA offices are expecting only a minor long-term fiscal impact.
