1 AN ACT to create 100.277 of the statutes; relating to: prohibiting the
2 installation, sale, and distribution of wheel weights and other wheel balancing
3 products that contain lead. ✓

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the installation, when replacing or balancing a tire on a motor vehicle, of a wheel weight or other wheel balancing product that contains lead, if the lead was intentionally added during the manufacture of the weight or other product. ✓ The bill also prohibits the sale or distribution of such a weight or other product. ✓

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 SECTION 1. 100.277^X of the statutes is created to read:

5 100.277 Lead wheel weights prohibited. ✓ (1) In this ✓ section, "motor
6 vehicle" means a motor vehicle required to be registered under ch. 341. ✓
