## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

The fiscal impact of Senate Bill (SB) 229 on the Department of Administration is indeterminate. The requirement that all agencies prepare an economic impact analysis for proposed rules was added to the administrative rules process in 2011 Wisconsin Act 21.
