1 AN ACT to amend 119.04 (1); and to create 118.293 of the statutes; relating to:

concussions and other head injuries sustained in youth athletic activities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.293 of the statutes is created to read:

118.293 Concussion and head injury. (1) In this section, "youth athletic activity" means an organized athletic activity in which the participants, a majority of whom are under 19 years of age, are engaged in an athletic game or competition against another team, club, or entity, or in practice or preparation for an organized athletic game or competition against another team, club, or entity. "Youth athletic activity" does not include a college or university activity or an activity that is incidental to a nonathletic program.

(2) In conjunction with the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association, the department shall develop guidelines and other information for the purpose of

educating athletic coaches and pupil athletes and their parents or guardians about the nature and risk of concussion and head injury in youth athletic activities.

- (3) At the beginning of a season for a youth athletic activity, the person operating the youth athletic activity shall distribute a concussion and head injury information sheet to each person who will be coaching that youth athletic activity and to each person who wishes to participate in that youth athletic activity. No person may participate in a youth athletic activity unless the person returns the information sheet signed by the person and, if he or she is under the age of 19, by his or her parent or guardian.
- (4) (a) A person who is suspected of sustaining a concussion or head injury in a youth athletic activity shall be removed from the youth athletic activity immediately.
- (a) may not participate in a youth athletic activity until he or she is evaluated by a health care provider who has been trained in the evaluation and management of concussion and head injuries and receives a written clearance to participate in the activity from the health care provider.
- (5) (a) Any athletic coach, official involved in an athletic activity, or volunteer who fails to remove a person from a youth athletic activity under sub. (4) (a) is immune from civil liability for any injury resulting from that omission unless it constitutes gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.
- (b) Any volunteer who authorizes a person to participate in a youth athletic activity under sub. (4) (b) is immune from civil liability for any injury resulting from that act unless the act constitutes gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.

1 (6) This section does not create any liability for, or a cause of action against. 2 any person. - 1. He or she holds a credential that authorizes the person to provide health care.
- 2. He or she is trained and has experience in evaluating and managing pediatric concussions and head injuries.
 - 3. He or she is practicing within the scope of his or her credential.

3. Page 2, line 10: delete lines 10 to 12 and substitute:

(4) (a) An athletic coach, or official involved in a youth athletic activity, or health care provider shall remove a person from the youth athletic activity if the coach, official, or health care provider determines that the person exhibits signs, symptoms, or behavior consistent with a concussion or head injury or the coach, official, or health care provider suspects the person has sustained a concussion or head injury.

4. Page 2, line 15: delete the material beginning with "who" and ending with "injuries" on line 16.
