**SENATE AMENDMENT 3,
TO 2011 SENATE BILL 270**

November 1, 2011 – Offered by Senator ERPENBACH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “circulators” insert “and disclosure of the identity of
3 nonresident circulators of recall petitions”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 19: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 1m.** 9.10 (2) (d) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 9.10 (2) (d) No petition may be offered for filing for the recall of an officer unless
7 the petitioner first files a registration statement under s. 11.05 (1) or (2) with the
8 filing officer with whom the petition is filed. The petitioner shall append to the
9 registration a statement indicating his or her intent to circulate a recall petition, the
10 name of the officer for whom recall is sought, the name and address of each
11 nonresident of this state who will circulate the petition on behalf of the petitioner,
12 and, in the case of a petition for the recall of a city, village, town, town sanitary
13 district, or school district officer, a statement of a reason for the recall which is related

1 to the official responsibilities of the official for whom removal is sought. No petitioner
2 may circulate a petition for the recall of an officer prior to completing registration.
3 The last date that a petition for the recall of an officer may be offered for filing is 5
4 p.m. on the 60th day commencing after registration. After the recall petition has
5 been offered for filing, no name may be added or removed. No signature may be
6 counted unless the date of the signature is within the period provided in this
7 paragraph.”.

8 **3.** Page 2, line 21: delete “This act” and substitute “The treatment of section
9 8.40 (2) of the statutes”.
