Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This estimate covers both the Legislative Reference Bureau and the Legislative Council.

Neither the Legislative Reference Bureau nor the Legislative Council maintains a list of collateral consequences to a conviction or a finding of delinquency. The increased costs would come from creating and keeping current the list from both the statutory consequences and the consequences in the administrative rules. Maintaining and keeping current the list of statutory consequences would be one additional task-- it would be an effort for the entire drafting section of attorneys because consequences are not limited to one drafting subject area, such as corrections. Maintaining and keeping current the list of administrative consequences would be an entirely new task for the LRB and the LC-- unlike statutory changes, changes in administrative rules are not monitored by legislative attorneys. The agencies could absorb the costs within the budgets, but staff would have to be diverted from current tasks to complete this task.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

An additional staff person may be necessary.
