Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, beginning with the 2012 spring primary election, an individual must present proof of identification that includes a photograph of the individual to vote in an election. Under current law, a driver's license or a state identification card issued by the Department of Transportation are permissible forms of identification for voting.

Under this bill, a resident of Milwaukee County may obtain a free birth certificate for one year following the effective date of the bill if the resident needs the birth certificate in order to obtain a driver's license or identification card for the purpose of voting.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.
