**Rep. Jacque's Testimony on AB 464
Committee on Judiciary and Ethics
February 2, 2012**

Chairman Ott and members of the Assembly Judiciary and Ethics Committee,

Thank you for holding this hearing on Assembly Bill 464 and the opportunity to further our state's policy discussion regarding tools for the prevention of youth and underage access to alcohol. Underage drinking is tremendous public health concern in Wisconsin; according to the most recent data from the federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, over 30% of Wisconsin 12 to 20 year olds report alcohol consumption within the past month and over 20 percent acknowledge binge drinking within the same period. A high percentage of those convicted of underage drinking offense admit to driving after consuming alcohol. It is a problem which pervades our culture to nearly epidemic proportions and requires a vigorous response and
