Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under this bill, if more than one attendant is on duty, a retailer of motor vehicle fuel must provide an employee to dispense gasoline if a vehicle is registered to a person with a disability. The retailer must post signs indicating that customers with disabilities may obtain assistance with fueling.

Prosecutors indicated that they have had limited casework related to provisions that currently exist, and the expansion of these duties in this bill would have no fiscal effect on their offices.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Prosecutors have experienced little casework related to the existing provisions, and anticipate that this bill's expansion of these requirements will not have a long-term fiscal effect on their offices.
