

Could you draft an amendment for SB 486 that would include the enrollment cap included in the Sub for AB 110?

The language is:

Pg4Ln3 (1r) LIMIT ON NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS. The number of scholarships awarded  
Pg4Ln4 under this section in any school year may not exceed 5 percent of the total number  
Pg4Ln5 of children with disabilities residing in this state in the previous school year, as  
Pg4Ln6 determined by the department.

The bill will be getting a public hearing on Feb 28th, so we would like it in advance of that.

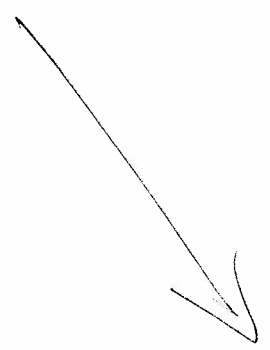

Hi Peter,

Today, there was some confusion in the Assembly Education Committee over the enrollment cap that was included in the Sub for AB 110. There were some members that took the language to read that it only covered new scholarships. They decided to amend the language to clarify that anyone that currently had a scholarship would also be included in the 5% cap.

To make everything uniform, we would like to have the same amendment drafted for SB 486. I haven't introduced the other cap language you sent me, so when I see the stripes, I will send them back.

The new language is:

**The total number of scholarship recipients under this section in any school year may not exceed 5 percent of the total number of children with disabilities residing in this state in the previous school year, as determined by the department.**

**SENATE AMENDMENT ,  
TO 2011 SENATE BILL 486**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 10: delete "Beginning" and substitute "Subject to sub. (1r),
