Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would increase the amount of information and frequency of reporting on certain contracts for engineering or architectural services, including analysis to determine the percentage of work currently performed by contractors that could be performed by department employees. There would be an additional administrative burden in regard to reporting on improvements to local road construction projects. However, it is likely the additional administrative burden created through this bill could be met by current department staff within the scope of their duties.
