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1           ***Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That:***

2           **SECTION 1. 2011-2012 session schedule.** (1) BIENNIAL SESSION PERIOD. The  
3 legislature declares that the biennial session period of the 2011 Wisconsin  
4 legislature began on Monday, January 3, 2011, and that the biennial session period  
5 ends at 12 noon on Monday, January 7, 2013.

6           (1m) BUDGET DEADLINE EXTENDED. The deadline of Tuesday, January 25, 2011,  
7 set by section 16.45 of the statutes for introduction of the executive budget bill or  
8 bills, submittal of the state budget report, and delivery of the governor’s budget  
9 message, is extended to Thursday, February 24, 2011.

10           (2) SCHEDULED FLOORPERIODS AND COMMITTEE WORK PERIODS. (a) *Unreserved*  
11 *days.* Unless reserved under this subsection as a day to conduct an organizational  
12 meeting or to be part of a scheduled floorperiod of the legislature, every day of the  
13 biennial session period is designated as a day for committee activity and is available  
14 to extend a scheduled floorperiod, convene an extraordinary session, or take senate  
15 action on appointments as permitted by joint rule 81.

16           (b) *Inauguration.* Pursuant to section 13.02 (1) of the statutes, the  
17 inauguration of the members of the 2011 legislature, and the organizing for business  
18 of the 2 houses, commences at 2 p.m. on Monday, January 3, 2011.

19           (c) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, January 11, 2011, at 10  
20 a.m., and ends on January 11, 2011.

1           (d) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, January 25, 2011, at 10  
2 a.m., and ends on Tuesday, February 10, 2011.

3           (e) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, February 22, 2011, at 10  
4 a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, February 24, 2011.

5           (f) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, March 8, 2011, at 10 a.m.,  
6 and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, March 10, 2011.

7           (g) *Bills to governor.* No later than Thursday, March 24, 2011, at 4:30 p.m., the  
8 chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action thereon all  
9 enrolled bills originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both  
10 houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session, on or before Monday, March 14,  
11 2011.

12           (h) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, April 5, 2011, at 10 a.m.,  
13 and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, April 14, 2011.

14           (i) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, May 10, 2011, at 10 a.m.,  
15 and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, May 19, 2011.

16           (j) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, June 7, 2011, at 10 a.m.,  
17 and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, June 30, 2011, but this floorperiod  
18 may not be adjourned until the general fund executive budget bill has been passed  
19 by both houses.

20           (k) *Nonbudget bills to governor.* No later than Thursday, August 4, 2011, at 4:30  
21 p.m., the chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action  
22 thereon all enrolled bills, except the general fund executive budget bill, originating  
23 in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both houses, in regular,  
24 extraordinary, or special session, on or before Friday, July 29, 2011.

1           (L) *Budget bill to governor.* No later than the later of Thursday, August 4, 2011,  
2           at 4:30 p.m., or 4:30 p.m. on the 4th Thursday after the general fund executive budget  
3           bill is passed by both houses in identical form, the chief clerk of each house shall  
4           submit to the governor for executive action thereon any enrolled general fund  
5           executive budget bill originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed  
6           by both houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session.

7           (m) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, September 13, 2011, at  
8           10 a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, September 22, 2011.

9           (n) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, October 18, 2011, at 10  
10          a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, November 3, 2011.

11          (o) *Bills to governor.* No later than Thursday, December 8, 2011, at 4:30 p.m.,  
12          the chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action thereon  
13          all enrolled bills originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both  
14          houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session, on or before Tuesday, November  
15          22, 2011.

16          (p) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, January 17, 2012, at 10  
17          a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, January 26, 2012.

18          (q) *Floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, February 14, 2012, at  
19          10 a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier, ends Thursday, February 23, 2012.

20          (r) *Last general-business floorperiod.* The last general-business floorperiod  
21          commences on Tuesday, March 6, 2012, at 10 a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier,  
22          ends on Thursday, March 15, 2012.

23          (s) *Bills to governor.* No later than Thursday, March 22, 2012, at 4:30 p.m., the  
24          chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action thereon all  
25          enrolled bills originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both

1 houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session, on or before Thursday, February  
2 23, 2012.

3 (t) *Limited-business floorperiod.* A floorperiod commences on Tuesday, April  
4 24, 2012, at 10 a.m., and, unless adjourned earlier, ends on Thursday, May 3, 2012,  
5 which is limited to matters allowed under joint rule 81m (2) to legislative  
6 and congressional redistricting, and to considering resolutions offered for the purpose of extending the  
7 commendations, condolences, or congratulations of the legislature to a particular  
8 person, group, or organization, or of recognizing a particular event or occasion.

9 (u) *Bills to governor.* No later than Thursday, May 10, 2012, at 4:30 p.m., the  
10 chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action thereon all  
11 enrolled bills originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both  
12 houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session, on or before Friday, May 4, 2012.

13 (v) *Veto review floorperiod.* A floorperiod, limited to matters allowed under joint  
14 rule 82 (1) (a) to (f), commences on Tuesday, May 22, 2012, at 10 a.m., and, unless  
15 adjourned earlier, ends on Wednesday, May 23, 2012.

16 (w) *Bills to governor.* No later than Wednesday, June 13, 2012, at 4:30 p.m., the  
17 chief clerk of each house shall submit to the governor for executive action thereon all  
18 enrolled bills originating in the chief clerk's house and having been passed by both  
19 houses, in regular, extraordinary, or special session, on or before Friday, June 8,  
20 2012.

21 (3) INTERIM PERIOD OF COMMITTEE WORK; NO FURTHER INTRODUCTIONS. Upon the  
22 adjournment of the May veto review floorperiod, there shall be an interim period of  
23 committee work ending on Monday, January 7, 2013. Unless the legislature is  
24 convened in one or more extraordinary or special sessions, no additional 2011  
25 legislation may be offered during this interim period of committee work.

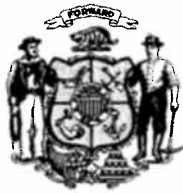

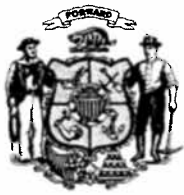
