



2011 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 3

January 11, 2011 – Introduced by Senators T. CULLEN and KEDZIE, cosponsored by Representatives WYNN and NASS. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** commending the University of Wisconsin–Whitewater football team
2 for winning a third national championship.

3 Whereas, the UW–Whitewater Warhawks became the National Collegiate
4 Athletic Association Division III champions for the third time in four years with a
5 31–21 victory over Mount Union College on December 17, 2010; and

6 Whereas, Whitewater has been in a six–year tug–of–war over the national
7 championship, with Whitewater winning three years and Mount Union winning
8 three years; and

9 Whereas, junior running back Levell Coppage scored three touchdowns and ran
10 299 yards on 39 carries, setting a new Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl rushing record; and

11 Whereas, Coppage’s 150 points for the season are the most scored by a player
12 in all football divisions in the NCAA; and

13 Whereas, senior Matt McCulloch, a Janesville Parker graduate, contributed
14 with eight tackles and two interceptions; and
