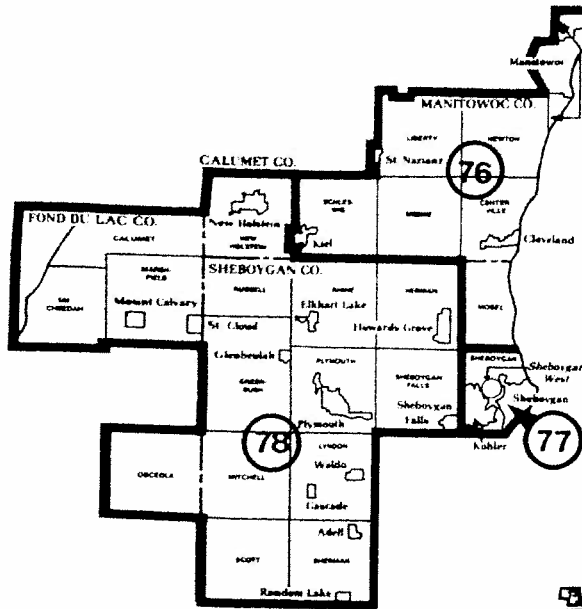

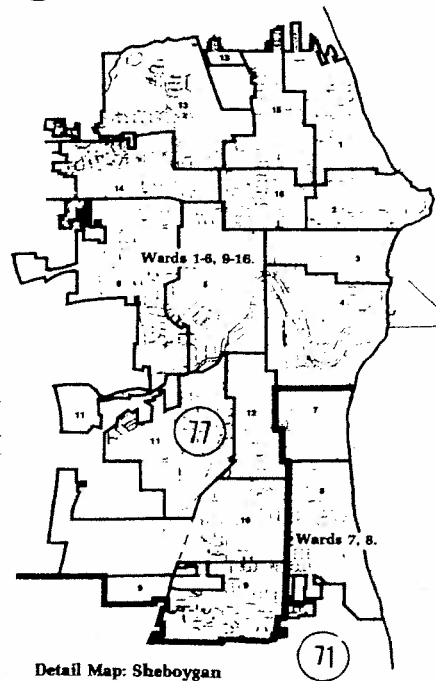

Member U.F.C.W. local (former exec. bd. pres.); Amer. Fed. of Musicians; Sheboygan County Labor Council (former COPE chp.); V.F.W.; Amer. Legion; Lutheran Layman's League; NCSL Task Force on Arts. Mbr. Police and Fire Comm. 1962-72; county board supervisor 1962-68.

Elected to Assembly in October 1967 special election; reelected 1968 to 1980; elected to Senate 1982. Biennial committee assignments: 1983 — Jt. Com. for Review of Administrative Rules (co-chp.); Jt.
