2 Whereas, William Clay Matthews III is a linebacker for the Super Bowl
3 Champion Green Bay Packers; and

4 Whereas, Clay Matthews was born May 14, 1986, and he played college football
5 at the University of Southern California. He was drafted by the Packers in the 2009
6 NFL Draft; and

7 Whereas, Clay Matthews set a Packers rookie record with ten sacks in 2009 on
8 his way to earning Pro Bowl honors, the first Packers rookie to be named to the
9 all-star game since 1978; and

10 Whereas, Clay Matthews was selected to the Pro Football Weekly/Pro Football
11 Writers of America All-Rookie team, earned the Pepsi NFL Rookie of the Week
12 honors twice, and was once named NFC Defensive Player of the Week; and

13 Whereas, Clay Matthews distinguished himself along with the great Packers
14 in the Super Bowl XLV victory over the Pittsburgh Steelers, helping the Packers win
15 their fourth Super Bowl title and their first title since Super Bowl XXXI; and
