Whereas, in 2010 Wisconsin passed legislation that included a state Farm to School grant program to be promoted by the Department of Agriculture; and

Whereas, Farm to School programs link schools and local farms in order to provide schools with nutritious foods for their meals and snacks that help children develop healthy eating habits; and

Whereas, kids eat 20% more fruits and vegetables if they are in a farm to school program and children learning healthy eating habits with agriculture and nutrition education encourages kids to develop other health habits which decreases childhood obesity; and

Whereas, farm to school programs save Wisconsin schools money due to less fluctuation in local farm prices, increased participation in the meal program when farm-fresh food is served, and local produce can cost less than processed foods schools typically use; and

Whereas, farm to school programs provide local farmers with new markets and the variety of local crops can provide opportunities for increased community economic development; now, therefore, be it

***Resolved by the [senate], the [assembly] concurring, That*** the Wisconsin legislature proclaims October 2011 as Farm to School Month.
