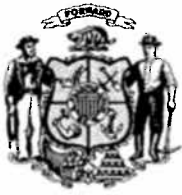

Page 2, line 13: replace "Cardinal Timothy Michael Dolan" with "Timothy Michael Cardinal Dolan"

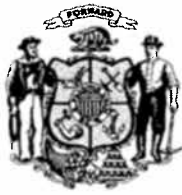
Page 2, line 14: replace "cardinalate" with "College of Cardinals"
