I'm not sure how ETF has categorized their requests, but here are the stat language requests from ETF that we would like assigned to us:

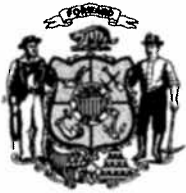
- 0073 1) Expenditure authority based on membership levels with the ability to carry remaining balances

Group Insurance Board:

- 0076 1) Clarify that GIB may offer wellness incentives
- 0077 2) Permit GIB to contract for data collection
- 0078 3) Broaden flexibility to determine long-term care insurance options

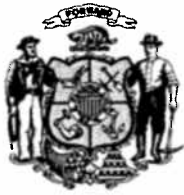
