- 0076 1) Clarify that GIB may offer wellness incentives
- 0077 2) Permit GIB to contract for data collection
- 0078 3) Broaden flexibility to determine long-term care insurance options

Current law permits the Group Insurance Board (GIB) to contract with the Department of Health Services and other public or private entities for data collection and analysis services related to health maintenance organizations and insurance companies that provide health insurance to state employees. 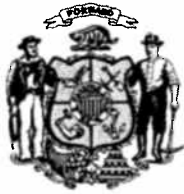
