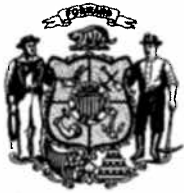

HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Under current law, generally, an unencumbered balance in any biennial appropriation from general purpose revenue reverts to the general fund at the end of the fiscal biennium. For the 2009-11 fiscal biennium, any unencumbered balance in the general purpose revenue appropriation for the Medical Assistance program remains in that appropriation account and does not revert to the general fund. DHS is currently allowed to expend that unencumbered balance in the 2009-11 fiscal biennium in addition to the amounts listed in the appropriation schedule for that appropriation account.

This bill requires that the unencumbered balance in the general purpose revenue appropriation account for the Medical Assistance program reverts to the general fund at the end of the 2009-11 fiscal biennium. DHS is not allowed to expend the amount of the unencumbered balance in that appropriation account in the 2009-11 fiscal biennium.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 2009 Wisconsin Act 28, section 9222 (1d) of the statutes is repealed.
