Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, DHS administers the Medical Assistance (MA) program, which is a joint federal and state program that provides health services to individuals who have limited resources. Some of the funding for the MA program derives from a general purpose revenue (GPR) appropriation account. This bill increases the amount the department may spend from the GPR account for fiscal year 2010-11 for the MA program for the purpose of funding the contribution for indigent health care for Milwaukee County.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 9221. Fiscal changes; Health Services.

3 (1) MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM BENEFITS APPROPRIATION INCREASE. In the
4 schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the
5 department of health services under section 20.435 (4) (b) of the statutes, as affected

1 by the acts of 2011, the dollar amount is increased by \$6,800,000 for the second fiscal
2 year of the fiscal biennium in which this subsection[✓] takes effect to fund the
3 contribution for indigent health care in Milwaukee County.
