





I have a few questions/requests related to the agency unclassified positions [LRB - 1222/2] draft. Please respond later today, or tomorrow morning at the latest.

Please provide the specific position, current pay, and pay scale for all positions that would deleted under this provision.

Please list the type of position classification and pay scale of the positions that would be created in all the affected agencies under the bill.
