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

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the number of unclassified division administrators by 36 FTE positions, decreases 36 FTE positions in executive branch agencies, which positions are to be determined by the secretary of administration, and permits the director of OSER to appoint either a deputy director or an executive assistant in the unclassified service.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
