This bill increases the number of unclassified division administrators by FTE positions, decreases 36 FTE positions in executive branch agencies, which positions are to be determined by the secretary of administration, and permits the director of OSER to appoint either a deputy director or an executive assistant in the unclassified service.

Additionally, the current DSF division administrator position (#7694) is split funded between 20.505(1)(kc) and 20.505(5)(ka). Can we convert this position to be 100% funded from 20.505(1)(kc)?
